GOLF COURSE UPDATE

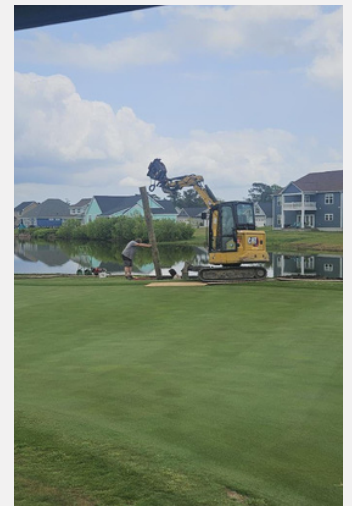
